Trail Report

Note: This information for this trail report was gathered BEFORE the main portion of the winter storm we are receiving. Trail conditions may change significantly in the next several days. Please use caution when riding.

Our trails are currently in excellent condition with a strong snow base. Trail 101 from the Oneida County line to Musky Jacks is in good condition but expect moguls and thin snow spots. Trail 102 between 121 and 103 is now being groomed regularly and conditions have improved. As always be mindful that our volunteer groomers and our tractor and drag are on the trail every day of the week. They may be going in the same direction that you are traveling but they also may be coming towards you. Keep this in mind especially around sharp curves. Use your head, watch your speed, and be safe.
