Trail Status

North: Trail 111/Corridor 19N	Good to Very Good – some bare spots, some rocks, especially north of Hwy 182.
Northwest: Trail 101/Corridor 10W	Good to Very Good – some bare spots, some spots with small rocks by the bridge close to 111/19N.
South: Trail 120/Corridor 19S	Very Good
Southwest: Trail 121	Very Good – a few areas where rocks are starting to appear.
East: Trail 101/Corridor 10E	Fair to Good – some bare spots and some spots with deep ruts.
Trail 102N between 121 & 103	Good
Trail 107	Very Good
Trail 108	Very Good
Trail 106/Corridor 19N	Good

Trail Report

All of our trails have about a fragile 2" of base snow. The warmup over the weekend extends through the middle of this week. Our trails have held up pretty well, but the roads took a beating. The exception is Trail 101/Corridor 10W between the Onieda/Price county line and Musky Jack's. This section of the trail has deteriorated badly and is basically dirt. Reducing speed while riding, especially on curves, will help preserve our fragile base. Ride right. Ride sober. Ride with caution.
